An English translation of the French text in which the author meditates upon his response to photographs, discussing the wonder he feels at being connected to the past, with a focus on a cherished picture of his mother.

Provides reproductions of 190 photographs taken by 160 artists from around the world and accompanied by brief annotations, and includes a discussion on the emergence of photography as an art form since the mid-1960s as well as related interview excerpts and quotes.
